Goal: In this exercise, the participants will be asked to build the backend of a TodoReact App. The user will be exploring the functionality of FeatherHttp, a server-side framework.

What is FeatherHttp: FeatherHttp makes it easy to write web applications.

Why FeatherHttp: FeatherHttp is lightweight server-side framework designed to scale-up as your application grows in complexity.

Setup

1. Install [git](#).
2. Install [.NET Core 3.1 SDK](#)
3. Install the template using the following command:

```
dotnet new -i FeatherHttp.Templates::0.1.64-alpha.g00afb18f22 --nuget-source https://f.feedz.io/featherhttp/fran
```
4. Install [Node.js](#)
5. Clone this repository and navigate to the Tutorial folder, this consists of the frontend application `TodoReact` app.

Task: Build the backend portion using FeatherHttp

Tasks

Run the frontend application

1. Once you clone the Todo repo, navigate to the `TodoReact` folder and run the following commands

```
\Tutorial\TodoReact> npm i
\tutorial\todoReact> npm start
```

- The commands above
 - Restores packages `npm i`
 - Starts the react app `npm start`

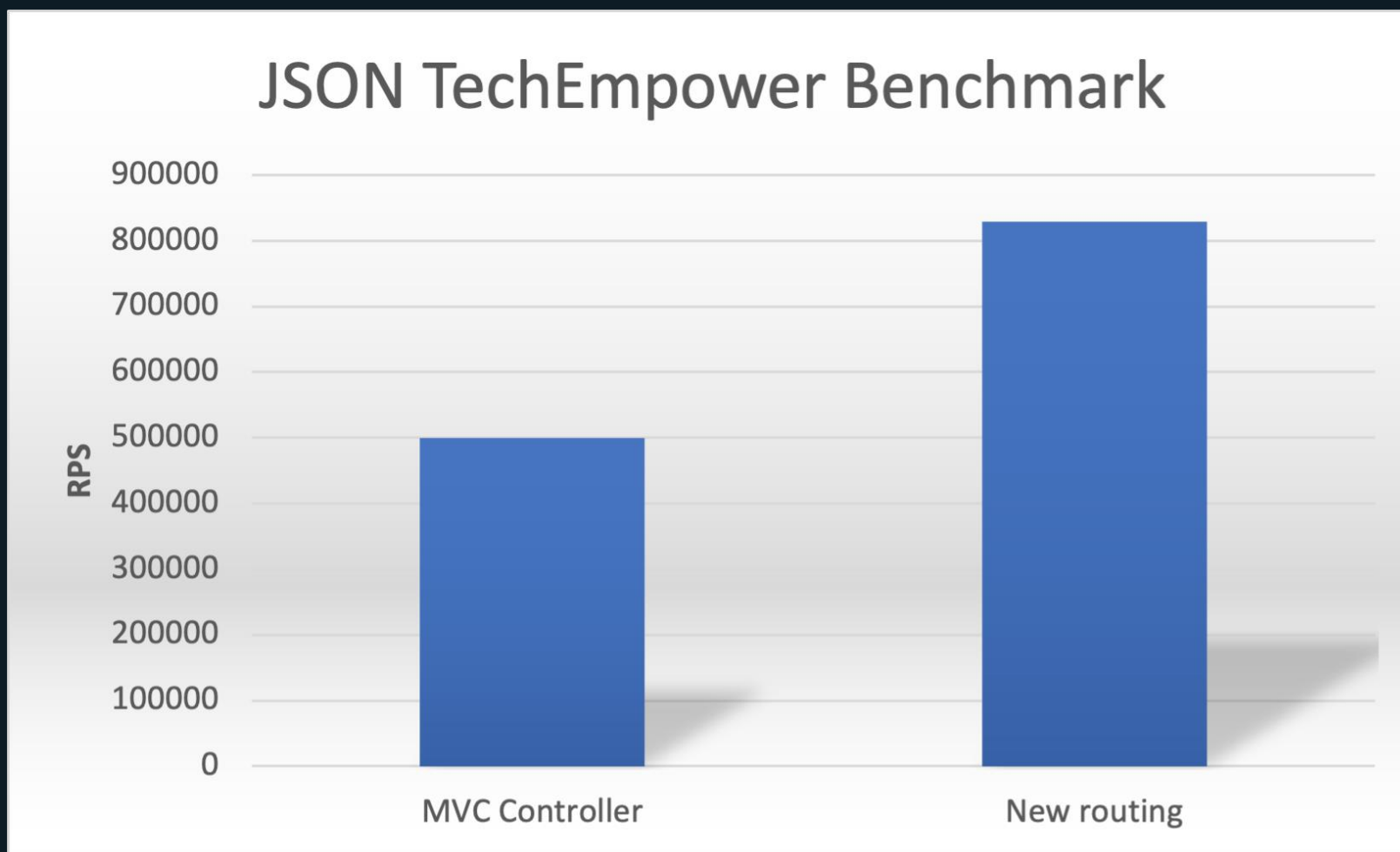
